On your computer Facebook page, go into your Facebook Settings, look for the Video tab on your left. When you click that, you will then find the Auto-Play Videos tab which comes up on the right. You can then click on that and determine if you want to leave it on Default, On or Off. I chose Off.

Now, what about your iPhone? Go to Settings. Scroll down to your Facebook app and dlick on it.

Just below the Facebook logo at the top you will see "Auto-Play on Wi-Fi Only". This is what I clicked on, so that it doesn't affect my bandwidth, too. But, remember, this is your mobile phone, and changing this setting doesn't work 100% of the time...for some reason. But, it definitely helps.
